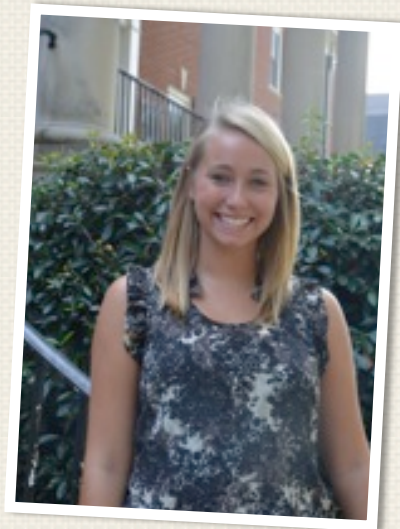


SOPHOMORE YEAR

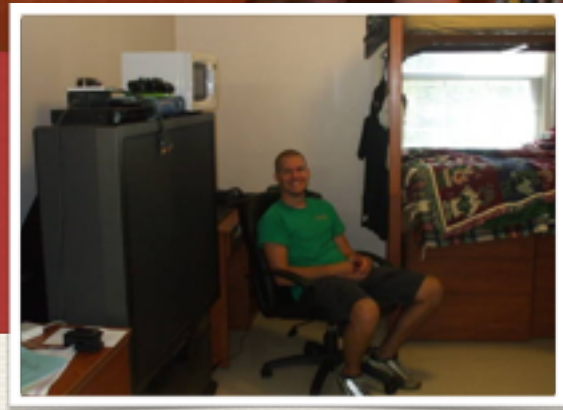
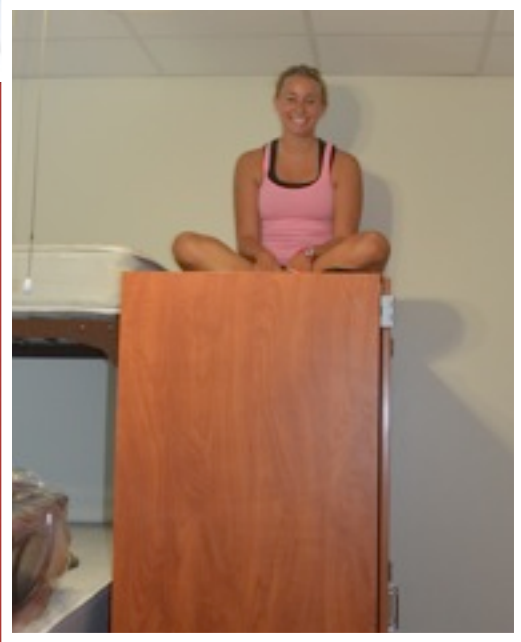
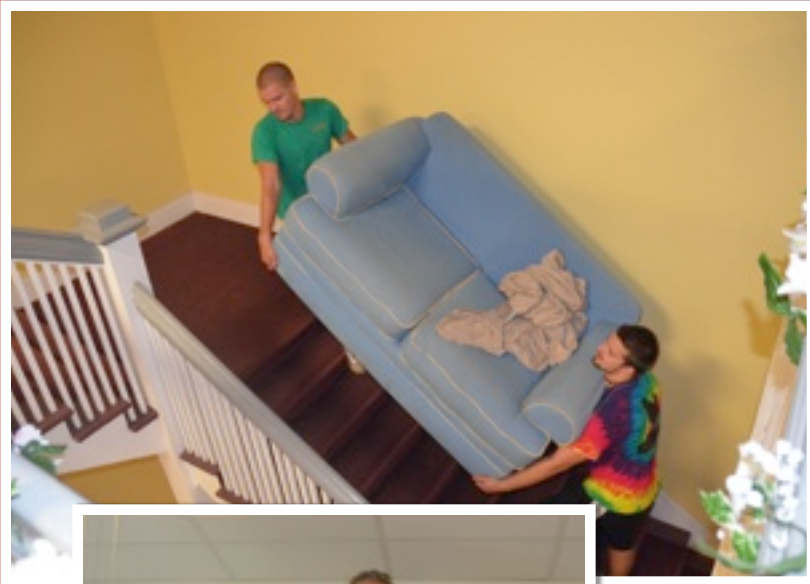
